a. REPI-003-21 Part I Called to the Floor By Chari Potts
Discussion

Rich Truitt in support of proposal. Would provide direction to Code Official that they can accept these standards as alternatives

Eric Lacey similar proposal RE-1 in 2021 was disapproved. That proposal was to set min level of silver of NGBS. Code Officials can already approve in exiting language. Adding this section suggests that you do not need to meet the mandatory provisions. The listed standards are not necessarily in compliance with IECC. Would caution that this proposal could provide pathway to a less efficient structure that would be required by the IECC. Recommend disapproval.

Maureen Guttman Echo comments by Eric. This would force jurisdictions to accept. Jurisdictions would find hard to remove in adoption process if they don't want this provision. Referenced PA Labor and Industry process. Recommends disapproval.

Rich Truitt. Commented that jurisdictions always have the right to remove through their own adoption process as established by law.

Michael Rhodes Questioned if both standards are produced by for profit entities.

Maureen Guttman Amending the code is based on specific jurisdiction and may be difficult to do.

Heather Goggin Echoes comments from Maureen Guttman

Maureen Guttman Clarified that LED is non profit and NGBS is produced by ICC

Motion move to recommend disapproval Maureen Guttman 2nd Michael Rhodes
