CED1-121 - cool wall SRI for climate zone 0

Motion: Greg Johnson moves as modified. Second from Jonathan Humble. Taking out "however" in definitions.

Modification:

Add new text as follows:

101 New Code Section.

north-oriented: facing within 67.5 degrees of true north in the northern hemisphere; (however, or facing within 67.5 degrees of true south in the southern hemisphere.)

south-oriented: facing within 45 degrees of true south in the northern hemisphere: (however, or facing within 45 degrees of true north in the southern hemisphere.)

east-oriented: facing within 45 degrees of true east to the south and within less than 22.5 degrees of true east to the north in the northern hemisphere; (however, or facing within 45 degrees of true east to the north and within less than 22.5 degrees of true east to the south in the southern hemisphere.)

west-oriented: facing within 45 degrees of true west to the south and within less than 22.5 degrees of true west to the north in the northern hemisphere: (hewever, or facing within 45 degrees of true west to the north and within less than 22.5 degrees of true west to the south in the southern hemisphere.)

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Vote: 16-0-1 CNV **Reason**: In addition to the original reason statement, AM is editorial corrections of existing language.

CED1-149 – exterior wall envelope terminology
Moved to after 203 due to overlap.
Motion: Jay Crandell/Rich Burton to approve.
Motion to table: Greg Johnson/Martha VanGeem to follow 203 (implied to be next meeting).

CED1-150 – update AISI standard reference **Motion**: Approve. Jonathan Humble/Maureen Guttman. **Vote**: 16-0-1 CNV

Reason: Agreed with the proponent's reason statement that this proposal corrected an error within the 2021 edition of the standard.

CED1-117 – envelope backstop
Motion: Disappove. Greg Johnson/Emily Lorenz
Vote: 9-8-1 cnv.
Reason: Reduces design flexibility, drives additional embodied energy, and does not save operational energy

Lorenz takes over as chair

CED1-142 – fenestration / envelope backstop Motion: Disapprove. Tom Culp/Martha VanGeem Vote: 14-3-1 cnv Reason: Restricts design flexibility without any energy savings, as the proposed building is still required to show equivalent energy performance. Therefore, does not meet cost effectiveness if increases cost without any energy savings. Also, the selected percentage is arbitrary.

Motion: Approve. Jay Crandell/Mike Tillou. Vote: 4-11-2 including cnv **Motion**: Disapprove. Greg Johnson/Emily Lorenz **Vote**: 13-1-2 including cnv. **Reason**: Reduces design flexibility, drives additional embodied energy, and does not save operational energy.

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CED1-197 – roof reflectance in performance path
Motion: Approve. Jay Crandell /Emily Lorenz
Vote: 10-0-4 including cnv
Reason: correlate use of solar reflectance with other parts of the code.

CED1-203 – secondary review, energy credits ← if ready from Modeling SC Motion: Disapprove. Greg Johnson/Emily Lorenz.
Motion to table until March 16: Bob Ross /Greg Johnson.
Vote: 12-1-2 cnv
