**ORDER**

For the reasons set forth in the accompanying Memorandum Opinion, it is hereby

**ORDERED** that Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment, ECF No. 199-1, is **GRANTED** in part as to the following findings: (1) Plaintiffs have established ownership in the copyrights for all Works at Issue; (2) All Works at Issue are supported by valid copyrights; (3) Defendants infringed upon Plaintiffs Works at Issue through reproduction; (4) Defendants' infringement of Plaintiffs' Work at Issue through the Stored Files was not fair use; and it is **FURTHER**

**ORDERED** that Plaintiffs' motion, ECF No. 199-1, as to infringement through creation of the Accused Works and fair use as to the Accused Works is **DENIED**; and it is **FURTHER**

**ORDERED** that Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment, ECF No. 200-4, is **DENIED**; and it is **FURTHER**

**ORDERED** that the Court permanently enjoins and restrains Defendants from obtaining, downloading, or maintaining the Works at Issue on the Laserfiche or other IAPMO Entity internal servers; and it is **FURTHER**

**ORDERED** that the Court enters a preliminary injunction prohibiting Defendants from infringing upon any of Plaintiffs' exclusive rights in any current or future copyrighted works.
