- a. Discuss REPI-150-01 Modification.
 - **1.** Proponent Jay Crandell comments he has added modifications per SC comments on March 8 Meeting and reviews presentations made in March 8 Meeting and comments on 5-0 non-quorum vote from March 8 Meeting.
 - 2. Rossmiller comments on "cavity" modification and "approved design" language.
 - - Public Comments -
 - **3.** Marino questions water intrusion and alterations with respect to IEBC type 1, 2, & 3 and concerns about how applies to additions further, how this applies only to alterations. Continuous insulation is confusing and may create construction difficulties.
 - 4. Crandell responds with specifics of language in proposal.
 - **5.** Marino confirms that exterior insulation will not be required by this Proposal. And questions how Cost Effectiveness would be able to applied to this Proposal.
 - **6.** Crandell responds with clarification of language in that flexibility is not intended.
 - **7.** Schwarz requests for clarification on roof insulation.
 - **8.** Crandell responds with summary of REPI-32 heard by main Committee and similarities to above deck roof insulation provision included in this Proposal, and possibility that consistency or inconsistency regarding roof insulation code citations can be coordinated in Public Comment phase.
 - **9.** Schwarz requests clarification of whether attic is required to be insulated under this Proposal if the roof shingles are replaced.
 - **10.** Crandell responds that is not required by this Proposal.
 - **11.** Meyers questions how "for the full extent" is meant to be understood by Code enforcement persons, and suggests removal of "for the full extent" because it is redundant and because it may create flaws in uniformity of application.

- **12.** Crandell responds on purpose of "full extent" is to allow constructability.
- **13.** Dent comments on roof insulation issue of R- versus U- discrepancy in Code as far as in the framing versus above deck, and asks SC whether such discrepancy should be allowed.
- **14.** Crandell responds that Commercial Code roof insulation is more accurate to payback and insulation values.
- **15.** Dent agrees with Crandell, highlights slight inconsistency if Proposal is adopted between Existing and New Construction sections of the Residential Energy Code, and comments that Proposal fills important void in Code.
- 16. Crandell agrees with Dent and comments on importance of consistency across Codes.
