4. Approval of the Agenda-Motion by Mary Koban. Second by John Hensley. Motion passes unanimously.

5. Approval of the Minutes-Motion by Mary Koban to approve the December 20, 2022 minutes. Second by John Hensley. Motion passes unanimously.

6. Administrative issues. Rob Salcido of PNNL provided an update to the interim performance indicator that was presented at the previous meeting. The removal of item REPI-91-22 from the analysis and thus the values of energy efficiency improvement from the 2021 IECC are roughly 6.6%. Requests came from the committee for PNNL/DOE to consider providing further methodology to their determination. Also to provide individual breakdowns on proposals, specifically air leakage. To consider adding the term “operational” in front of emissions. DOE clarified that a cost effectiveness analysis as mandated will only come after the publication of the 2024 IECC.

a) Remove all-electric appendix proposals. Motion by Mike Stone to follow the recommendation of the Electrical Power, Lighting, Renewable and Storage subcommittee for disapproval. Second by Bob Raymer. Motion to call the question by Ric Johnson with a second from Gayathri Vijayakumar. Motion passes 33-4. Reason: The proponents present discussed their reasons for not supporting the inclusion of an All-Electric Appendix in the 2024 IECC. However, since the Appendices are optional for adoption by individual Jurisdictions and the Appendix was supported by voting members and members of the public during the initial public input phase, the SC members voted to Disapprove all the proposals that completely removed this new Appendix. Instead, the SC is open to considering modifications of this Appendix in order to address specific concerns identified by proponents during public comment. Motion for

Instead, the SC is open to considering modifications of this section in order to address specific concerns identified by proponents during public comment.
