CEPI-185-21 Horticultural Lighting

- Presentation by proponent (NBI)
- Question by Jack Bailey: Change of greenhouse definition of 50% skylight / roof ratio
- Ali: Generally in support of proposal, but question about it applying to all greenhouse lighting
- Jon McHugh: Comment about skylight ratio
- Steve Rosenstock: Can you use daylight dimming rather than daylight hold strategy?
- Payam: Question about 50% and warehouse conversion
- Endorsed by NEMA High-Performance Building Council
- Hope: Concerns related to definitions, man projects in Colorado would not meet the skylight definition
- Bernie: Cannot support the proposal
- Jon: 1.9 micromoles still allows for high pressure sodium and asks if we are getting anything from the proposal
