RE2D-18-23, Electric-resistance space heating
Replace comment with the following modification to PCD2 (same modification to IRC Chapter 11):

R403.7.1 Electric-resistance space heating. Where a detached Detached one- and two-family dwellings and or townhouses in Climate Zones 4 through 8 using is proposed to use electric-resistance space heating shall limit the total for more than 50 percent of its total installed heating capacity, the installed heating capacity of all electric-resistance space heating serving the dwelling unit to-shall be not more than 2.0 kW, or shall install a heat pump in the largest space that is not used as a bedroom.

Exception: Where a heat pump serves the entire *dwelling unit* or the largest space other than a bedroom, the installed heating capacity of electric-resistance space heating shall not be limited.
