This new committee is being formed in cooperation with the American Society for Healthcare Engineering (ASHE). The objective of this committee is to develop code change proposals to the International Codes which will result in the most contemporary, effective and efficient provisions for hospital and ambulatory care facilities to assure the highest level of safety for all users of such facilities. Based on the scope of this new effort, the Code Technology Committee (CTC) activities on the Care Facilities area of study will be transferred to this newly formed committee. The committee will be comprised of approximately 15 members representing ICC and ASHE.
