CTC MEETING #25 RELOCATABLE MODULAR REPORT

The Relocatable Modular SG has not met following the 2012 Final Action Hearing. The two key code changes, G198 – 12 and G203 – 12 were both Disapproved at the 2012 Final Action. The following is a staff report on possible Group B activities:

CTC Code change G203, including CTC's public comment, attempted to revise IBC Chapter 34 as follows:

<u>RELOCATABLE BUILDING.</u> A partially or completely assembled building constructed and designed to be reused multiple times and transported to different building sites.

3401.1 (IEBC [B] 401.1) Scope. The provisions of this chapter shall control the alteration, repair, addition and change of occupancy, and the relocation of existing buildings and structures.

Exception: Existing bleachers, grandstands and folding and telescopic seating shall comply with ICC 300.

3410.1 (IEBC [B] 409.1) Conformance. Structures moved into or within the jurisdiction shall comply with the provisions of this code for new structures.

Exception: Existing relocatable buildings moved into or within the jurisdiction shall be permitted to comply with the provisions of Chapter 13 of the International Existing Building Code.

<u>3410.2 (IEBC [B] 409.2) Additions, and Alterations, or Change of Occupancy.</u> Additions, alterations, or change of occupancy classification from one group to a different group made to relocatable buildings shall comply with the applicable provisions of Section 3403 and 3404 or the International Existing Building Code.

In light of the Disapproval of the code changes to the IBC, the IEBC focus could be on Chapter 13 Relocated or Moved Buildings. In Chapter 3 of the IEBC, there are 3 compliance methods:

- Prescriptive compliance per Chapter 4. If G 203 was approved, the resulting text would have benn added to IEBC Chapter 4.
- Work area compliance per IEBC Chapters 5 13
- Performance compliance per Chapter 14 (this is the same as Section 3412 of the IBC)

The following is a possible proposal to introduce "relocatable buildings" to the IEBC.

CHAPTER 13 RELOCATED OR MOVED BUILDINGS 1301 GENERAL

1301.1 Scope. This chapter provides requirements for relocated or moved structures, including relocatable buildings as defined in Chapter 2.

1301.2 Conformance. The building shall be safe for human occupancy as determined by the *International Fire Code* and the *International Property Maintenance Code*. Any *repair*, *alteration*, or *change of occupancy* undertaken within the moved structure shall comply with the requirements of this code applicable to the work being performed. Any field-fabricated elements shall comply with the requirements of the *International Building Code* or the *International Residential Code* as applicable.

Add term and definition to IEBC Chapter 2 as follows:

RELOCATABLE BUILDING. A partially or completely assembled building constructed and designed to be reused multiple times and transported to different building sites.
