#### Scope

• To assess what constitutes an appropriate balance of active and passive fire protection requirements with respect to meeting the fire safety goals of the I-Codes

Modify goals and objectives to the following:

## **Goals/Objectives**

- 1. To identify the code requirements applicable to active and passive fire protection
- 2. Define "acceptable level of fire safety"
- 3. Develop a methodology in order to determine "acceptable levels of fire safety"
- 4. Define "balanced fire protection design"
- 5. Assess the balance of active and passive fire protection code requirements using the methodology developed per objective #3
- 6. Determine appropriate code requirements to achieve acceptable levels of fire safety

## Balanced Fire Protection – Proposed Work Plan Propopsed 9-19-2005

- 1. CTC to revise their scope and objectives
- 2. CTC to define terms
  - a. "Acceptable levels of fire safety"
  - b. "Balanced fire protection design"
- 3. CTC to set up task group to develop a methodology in order to determine "acceptable levels of fire safety"
- 4. CTC to set up task group to develop fire scenarios for the methodology identified in item #3
- 5. CTC to establish a task group of stakeholders to participate the methodology identified in item #3
- 6. Completion of a comparative matrix by interested parties for the subject matter to be considered
- 7. Identification of specific subjects by interested parties for CTC to review. Subjects may or may not be on the comparative matrix
- 8. Identification and submission of supporting docs by interested parties Koffel consequence analysis approach, if used, would be here as one way of evaluating the issue.
- 9. CTC meeting(s) to discuss. By-product of the evaluation of an issue may be some type of methodology to evaluate issues.
- 10. CTC issue findings in a report
- 11. Public hearing on report
- 12. Report finalized and submitted to CEO per CP #5, including whether CTC to determine whether or not to submit code changes thru ICC CDP
