IBHS CAMPUS COVID VISITOR PROTOCOLS

IBHS is committed to the health and safety of everyone on the team and those visitors with whom we interact. Since the outbreak in March of 2020, IBHS has successfully instituted health protocols to mitigate transmission of the virus. No person-to-person transmission has occurred on its campuses. All visitors are required to follow these protocols.

Failure to follow these protocols will result in an immediate request to leave the IBHS Campus.

Pre-Visit Protocols

- o All visitors must complete and sign the <u>IBHS on-line liability waiver</u> prior to arrival on campus.
- o IBHS recommends that visitors 'test to travel' and take a COVID test prior to traveling to any meetings at our facility.
- o Dependent on current COVID infection numbers, IBHS reserves the right to revert to previous protocols requiring all visitors to be fully vaccinated.

Visit Protocols

- o If you are positive for COVID, have reason to believe that you may be positive, have been in close contact with someone who is positive, or are experiencing COVID-like symptoms, we ask you not to enter IBHS's campuses.
- o Depending on COVID case numbers, IBHS *may* require onsite antigen testing for COVID of its guests and staff. IBHS will supply the test.
- o Wash your hands frequently.
- o Use step-n-pulls that have been installed on doors to facilitate their opening, using your foot instead of grabbing the door handle.
- o Cough or sneeze into your elbow or shirt; immediately wash your hands if coughing/sneezing into your hands.
- Dependent on current COVID infection numbers, IBHS may require a multi-layer mask that is closefitting, covering your nose, mouth, and chin. We will provide you an effective covering, if needed. Masking is not required when actively eating or drinking; but be prudent.
- o Be conscientious of other's comfort level with up-close contact, sneezing, or coughing. When appropriate, give the other person more space.

Post-Visit Protocols

o Report back to IBHS any positive COVID test or experience of COVID symptoms if developed within 10 days of leaving the Research Center. If symptoms or a positive test is experienced within 10 days, please report them to dailytemp@ibhs.org.
