Notes from 2-6-2023 -

Discussion of 04-01-22 -

- The committee looked at revisions provided by Dan Victor to address the issue of seats where the aisle accessways are blocked by columns or wheelchair spaces.
- The committee had agreed during the 1/23/2023 meeting to revisions to 405.1 and 405.2 to separate aisle requirements from aisle width.
- The committee agreed to revised text in Section 407.1 for aisle accessways. 8-0-1
- The committee wanted allow some further work on possible exceptions. Dan Victor will be providing a graphic example for the 2/27/2023 meeting.

The current status of the proposed text under consideration is as follows.

# SECTION 408

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Inter-aisle Accessway Stairs.

# 408.1 Inter-aisle Accessway Stairs. An aisle accessway shall be permitted to egress

- through the adjacent aisle accessway where all of the following are met:
- 1. The elevation change between aisle accessways shall consist of one or two risers.
- <u>2.</u> Where a tread is provided, the depth shall be 11 inch (280 mm) minimum and the width shall be 22 inches (559 mm) minimum. The tread shall not obstruct the required clear aisle accessway width.
- 3. For other than folding and telescopic seatings, riser height shall be 4 inches (102 mm) minimum and 8 inches (204 mm) maximum. For folding and telescopic seating, the riser height shall be 4 inches (102 mm) minimum and 10.5 inches (267 mm) maximum.
- 4. A handrail complying with Section 409 shall be provided adjacent to the riser.
- 5. The minimum width of the adjacent aisle accessway shall accommodate the combined number of seats in the two rows.

Staff notes: Below are the definition of stair and stairway in the IBC. Neither is defined in the ICC 300. Please note that the requirements in Section 406 for stairs and stepped aisles in are for the entire walking surface, and on top of the aisle provisions in Section 405. What is proposed is a one or two step change between floor surface of aisle accessway walking surfaces. If you call this a stair, Section 406.1 sends you to the IBC for stairway requirements. To call this a stair could be interpreted to require many items that that are not intended at this location, such as width and landings. Another option might be to call this a transition between aisle accessway similar to 406.9 or 'path of travel' as indicated in Sections 407.4.1 and 407.4.2. The committee suggested the strike out of 'required clear width', but loosing that could be too open for interpretation for what constituted an obstruction.

**[BE] STAIR.** A change in elevation, consisting of one or more risers.

**[BE] STAIRWAY.** One or more *flights* of *stairs*, either exterior or interior, with the necessary landings and platforms connecting them, to form a continuous and uninterrupted passage from one level to another.
