The review was to determine whether the proposed reformatting satisfied the Public Comment IS-FPI 48-17 that was approved at the October 16, 2017 committee meeting. - The committee reviewed and adjudicated on the formal request from Mr. John Stahl
 to reconsider the previous disapproval of IS-FPI 27-17 that occurred at the April 25 –
 27, 2017 committee meeting. The committee voted to uphold the previous
 disapproval on a 7-1 vote.
