Talking Points

What is the Code of Honor Scholarship program?

- The International Code Council offers the **Code of Honor Scholarships** to its Governmental Member Voting Representatives seeking financial support to attend and participate in the Public Comment Hearings, which run from Wednesday, October 24 through Wednesday, October 31.

Who Funds the Code of Honor Scholarship program?

- The International Code Council provides significant funding through its annual budget to support the program.
- Other partner organizations voluntarily support the program through contributions.
- Scholarship applications and awards are processed confidentially, with no tie to voluntary contributions.

Benefits:

- Expense reimbursement
- Be part of the code development process and help develop the next generation of I-Codes
- Capacity building opportunities with building safety professionals
- Special Recognition (**Suggestions: Announcement at the annual meeting, BSJWeekly, Recognition pins or plaques?**)
- Career building and advancement

Who May Apply:

- Currently employed and serving as Governmental Member Voting Representatives

Award Levels:

- Scholarships provide up to \$2,000. These scholarships do not require a match.
- Match Scholarships provide up to \$1,000. Applicants must secure a pledge from their Chapter, jurisdiction, or use personal funds to match the scholarship award on a one-to-one basis.
- Only one scholarship per year will be awarded to each award winner.

Award Overview:

- Scholarship awards will fund eligible travel, lodging and ground transportation on a cost-reimbursement basis.
- Scholarships do NOT cover meals or per diem.
- Winners are required to attend and participate in Public Comment Hearings.
- Attendance and participation will be verified through on-site check-in and via verification that the winner attended and voted in the relevant hearings.
- Scholarship recipients will be required to sign an ethics pledge and complete a professional ethics briefing.

Application Procedure:

- For 2018, the scholarship application period will open on **May 28th** and close on **August 10th**.
- Applications must be completed and submitted online in one session.
- Applicants should gather all necessary application information (length of membership/service on Code Council committees, accreditations and/or certifications, number of community service hours, etc.) prior to completing the online application form.

- Scholarship recipients planning to register for and attend conference will receive a special registration rate.
