- 1) Call to Order/Roll Call/Welcome guests (Metz/Fippinger) Meeting called to order and roll call at 1:35pm ET by Chair Metz
- 2) Guest Presentation

Update from ICC Fire Code Action Committee

Beth Tubbs, Senior Staff Engineer FCAC Staff Secretariat International Code Council

FCAC has been extremely busy with proposals. Beth provided an overview of major code change proposals. 83 proposals have been submitted by the Fire Code Action Committee (FCAC). Members of the Building Code Action Committee (BCAC) also reviewed several of the FCAC proposals in their scope. All of the proposals were sponsored, reviewed and passed by FCAC.

- a. Several proposals focus on definitions.
- b. Some proposals aim to clarify when tests are required for fire alarm systems. Only places where a fire alarm would be present.
- c. A few clarifications regarding smoke alarms, building code, property maintenance.
- d. Big reorganization of Chapter 33, no changes. New provisions for exit signs.
- e. Continuing to work on ESS and correlating changes with NFPA 855.
- f. IWUIC proposals on vents and testing standards.
- g. Code change proposals for outdoor tents, bounce houses, outdoor dining, outdoor storage including pallets, and valet trash. Proposal for new appendix on valet trash.
- h. Other proposals include prohibiting temporary spray booths, mobile food trucks, rooftop storage, mobile on-demand fueling, and mobile hydrogen fueling.

Next steps – waiting for publishing of proposals. Work groups will meet again to review the proposals. The we'll be on to public comments and review of public comments.

Questions/Comments:

- a. Chief Metz This was the 1st code cycle without regional work groups. How did it go?
 - a. In person meetings did not occur due to COVID so meetings were virtual anyway. Good participation due to virtual meetings.
 - b. Karl stated the large number of groups available made the process interesting to manage. Beth worked to streamline process with volume of participants.
- b. Comment from Kelly Nicolello that FCAC should look to better "vet" what is FCAC issue vs "industry" issues. Could make workload more manageable.
 - a. Joe McElvaney commented that industry must go to FCAC "early" in process to get a proposal reviewed.
- c. Some proposals dealt with regulating new industries.

Chair Metz stated there were 280 proposals put forward. Participation in code hearings is expected to be good due to ability to attend virtually.
