Introduction to the Chief Knowledge Officer and the Code Council's Digital Transformation Strategy

Joan O'Neil Chief Knowledge Officer International Code Council

Joan discussed virtual task force formation and the creation of the ICC digital strategy. Needed to find ways to better serve our customers in the virtual world. Efforts informed by recent Code Council Government Relations surveys. Digital transformation is at the top of our priorities. Three areas that affect the Fire Service Membership Council are online resources, online education and cloud-based services with a focus on our Digital Codes product. Looking at a cohesive strategy to bring our Learning Center and Assessment Center to bring these two entities together more cohesively. Developing online permitting, virtual inspections and plan review solutions. Questions from the committee followed the presentation.

 - i) Chief West reported on maintaining good meeting quality during COVID using our virtual meeting format.
 - ii) Noted strong working relationships with other membership councils, particularly the Building Membership Council.
 - iii) I've been fortunate to participate in this group for a long time. In the process I've been able to move up as vice-chair and then as chair. As you know, we have all been granted another year to participate on the governing committee due to COVID. I feel like it's most important for this group to continue rotating our chair position as we always do every two years. It's unfortunate we haven't had any face-to-face meetings. I'll be appointing a nominating committee for our next meeting. I think we've done a good job with succession and preparing our people for the future.
 - c) Vice Chair's Report (Metz)
 - i) Chief Metz expressed his thanks for Chief West's leadership over the past two years as chair. Chief Metz reported he continued his participation in the Board Committee on the Long-Term Code Development Process or Blue Ribbon Committee. Chief Metz has also been appointed to the ICC Industry Advisory Committee Cost Evaluation Subcommittee to give a recommendation to the board on incorporating cost-benefit analyses for all code change proposals in the future. May affect proposals in the next code development cycle.

 - ii) Updates to NFSA Fire Sprinkler Tax Incentives Guide (Michehl)
 - (1) George Michehl reported on the fire sprinkler tax incentive law. Fire sprinkler tax incentives were cleaned up and updated under the CARES Act. Revised NFSA document includes the latest updates to the program including a risk assessment worksheet. Adds Section 13201 under CARES Act (see page 5); allows businesses to deduct up to 100% of their sprinkler system up to \$1.4 million dollars. Document includes a sample letter for fire chiefs on page 11 and a press release on page 12. NFSA Fire Sprinkler Tax Incentives Guide attached to minutes and available on the NFSA web site at www.nfsa.org in the store.
 - (2) Jeff Shapiro suggested this as a future topic as an introductory session for a future FSMC meeting.
