Jeffco Issues First Contractor License Ed Peck, Jeffco Building Safety Division

Jefferson County's
Building Safety
Division issued the
first contractor license
in Jeffco and it was
earned by one of its
own employees. The
contractor license was
issued to Henry Mifflin
of Jefferson County
Open Space. Mifflin



acquired a Class A General Contractor License, which he will use for Jeffco Open Space projects.

Mifflin assisted the Building Safety Division with a soft rollout of the program in December and the formal implementation started Jan. 1, 2014. Licensing will help streamline closing out permits smoothly, efficiently and avoid expiring permits.

Requirements for New Licenses and Renewals

The requirements and conditions for issuance of a Jefferson County Contractors License include:

- The submission of a contractor license application.
- Proof that you have passed an appropriate International Code Council (ICC) ICC exam within the last three years or provide a copy of a valid license issued from an ICC participating jurisdiction.
- Provide proof of lawful presence for the president/principal of the company applying (photo ID).
- Payment of the \$50 licensing fee.

Licenses are good for one year and must be renewed annually. Contractors holding valid licenses who apply for renewal cannot have any unresolved building code issues (expired permit, expired temporary certificate of occupancy, illegal occupancy, etc.) connected with building permits issued to or on behalf of the contractor licensee at time of renewal.
