

ICC Referenced Standard Committee



Scope and Purpose

The committee was re-formulated as a standing committee in 2005 by the Standards Council. In January 2006, the newly formed committee held its initial meeting, and adopted the following scope and purpose statements that it believes reflect the charge given by the Standards Council:

Scope: To support the codes development committees through the review of reference standards for the International Codes.

Purpose:

- To improve the codes through the review of proposed new reference standards when evaluated against ICC Council Policy 28-05, Section 3.6.
- To provide recommendations to the Code Councils, Code Development Committees and ICC Staff concerning proposed new reference standards.
- To provide a review and recommendation(s) concerning the proposed updating of existing reference standards when brought before the RSC by the Code Councils, Code Development Committees or ICC Staff.
- Existing reference standards currently within the I-codes may be monitored by the RSC, to determine compliance with ICC Council Policy 28-05 Section 3.6. The RSC may recommend appropriate action in accordance with ICC Council Policy 28-05 when warranted.
